

### **Directions:**

#### Prep:

Print the desired page. One per student for the books and worksheets.

#### How to use:

Christmas categories game board - use as a typical game board with game pawns and a dice. Alternately, have students color in the pictures after they tell you the category or name an association for each picture (e.g. presents go with a Christmas tree.)

Categories worksheet - students cut and glue the pictures into the correct category. Color the pictures afterward, if there is time left.


Prepositions books - fold the paper into quarters to make a book. Students can either draw an ornament in the correct position on each page or they can use a dot marker to create their "ornament" in the right spot.

Pronouns worksheets - put a paperclip on the end of a pencil and spin it on the gingerbread spinner area. Use that pronoun to make a grammatically correct sentence (e.g. The cookies are for me. / I made cookies.) according to the directions on each page.

Open-ended dotting page - students can use dot markers to color in each Christmas light on the image. There are 20 lights that are not covered by the letters and can be colored or covered. Alternately, use with mini markers or magnetic chips. Students should color/cover each Christmas light after completing any articulation/language target.

Spanish articulation dotting pages - students can use dot markers, mini erasers, pompoms, crayons, or whatever else you desire to color the images after they say the word. A word list is along the bottom to help with picture identification. Each page has either 25 or 50 trials.

Spanish "No" worksheet - students will cross off the item in each line per the question (e.g. "which one is not a present?").
